LSC Enrolment

HOW TO ENROL

1. Complete the Enrolment Form
2. Send the Enrolment Form to either:
(a) an LSC representative in your country; or
(b) directly to the LSC centre of your choice
3. With your Enrolment Form, send either:
(a) the Total Fees (payment for all services for the entire length of your stay); or (b) a Deposit (payment for all services requested during the first 4 weeks of your stay)
4. After receipt of your Enrolment Form and your payment, LSC will mail you a Letter of Acceptance.
5. If you require a visitor visa to enter Canada or study permit, present your Letter of Acceptance to the nearest Canadian Embassy or Consulate.

CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

LSC fee payment and refund policy are subject to Canadian provincial legislation.

1. **Visitor Visa, Study Permit, Work Permit**
It is the responsibility of the student to obtain all documents necessary to enter Canada. LSC Language Studies Canada cannot be held responsible if a student fails to obtain the proper documents to enter Canada or to study at one of our LSC centres.
2. **Complete Fee Payment**
Upon arrival at the LSC centre and before the start of studies, the student must complete payment of fees for all selected services. First day of school begins at 08:30.
3. **Observance of LSC Regulations**
All students agree to observe LSC rules and regulations.
4. **LSC Refund Policies**
All students agree to accept the LSC refund policies.

LSC Refund and Dispute Policies

Any changes made to Program are subject to LSC refund policy.
The Registration Fee is non-refundable.
Tuition fees are non-transferable.

'Program' Definition in Tuition Refund
Program = total weeks of all tuition services reserved at time of enrolment.

Rejection by Immigration Canada
Students who are unable to obtain the appropriate documents to enter Canada are entitled to a complete refund less the Registration Fee. Students must request the refund in writing and return the original LSC Letter of Acceptance with a copy of the letter of rejection from Immigration Canada to the appropriate LSC centre.

ACCOMMODATION REFUND
Students must provide written notification a minimum of 4 full weeks in advance in order to qualify for a refund of unused accommodation fees. There is a \$200 administration fee charged on accommodation cancelled prior to arrival.

DISPUTE POLICY
If you have any concerns, please come to the LSC Office for assistance. Final dispute resolution is the responsibility of the School Director or Registrar.
